

Pool & Process

Project Profile

Limited space and a long client wish list posed a challenge for this landscape design. The clients wanted a recreation hub to include many components to work well together. The program included a 600 square foot swimming pool, hot tub for year round use, fire pit, grill station, lighting and of course landscape plantings with irrigation. A thought out and coordinated design plan was executed and the project managed succinctly.



The pool was laid out using stakes and wood forms. The forms represent the outer edge of the pool shell and establish the exact elevation, location, size, shape, and position of the finished pool



The excavation process is now done. A portion of the earth from the pool was hauled away and a portion was kept on site for backfilling as necessary for later phases of construction.



The Gunite shell was the next major step in the construction project. Backfilling performed, and preliminary deck grading took place.



Now the paver deck area was installed at the proper elevation with positive pitch away from pool coping. The plumbing, electrical, gas, were installed prior to deck layout.

The project really comes to life with the blue water accentuated by the grey finish of the pool deck pavers. The result is a relaxing oasis to escape into at the work day's end.
